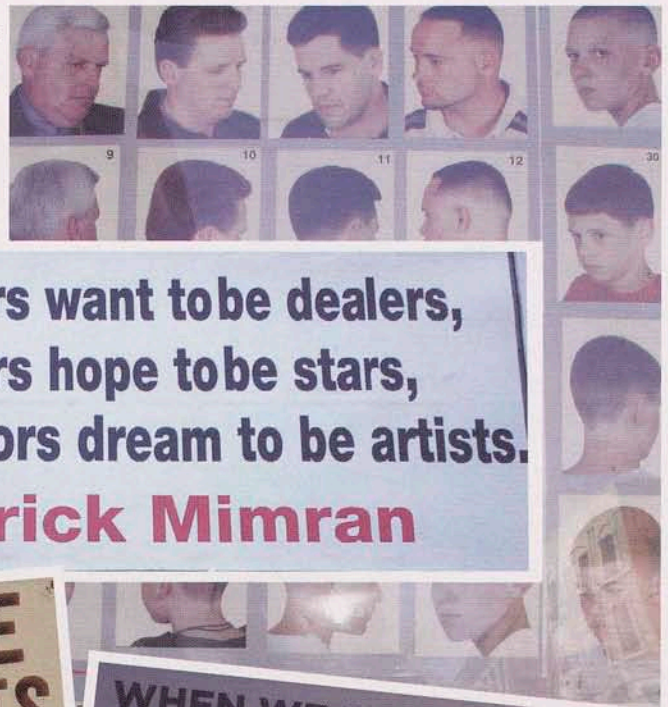

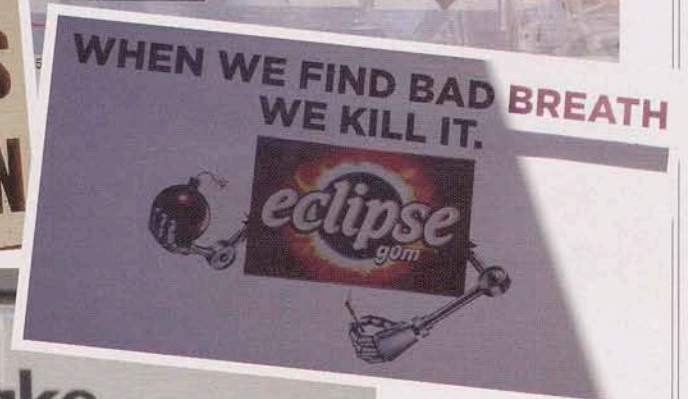
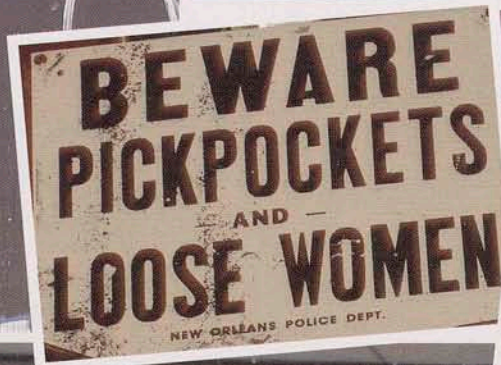

NEW YORK MARBLE CEMETERY

INCORPORATED 1831

ENCLOSED WITHIN THIS BLOCK IS THE OLDEST PUBLIC NON-SECTARIAN CEMETERY IN THE CITY. DESCENDANTS OF THE 19TH CENTURY OWNERS MAY STILL BE BURIED HERE. THE 156 SOLID MARBLE VAULTS WERE BUILT COMPLETELY UNDERGROUND AS A HEALTH PRECAUTION. THOUGH NO MARKERS ARE ON THE GROUND, NAMES OF THE ORIGINAL OWNERS FROM EACH FAMILY ARE ON MARBLE TABLETS IN THE SURROUNDING WALLS. THE CEMETERY IS A NEW YORK CITY LANDMARK AND IS ON THE NATIONAL REGISTER OF HISTORIC PLACES.
